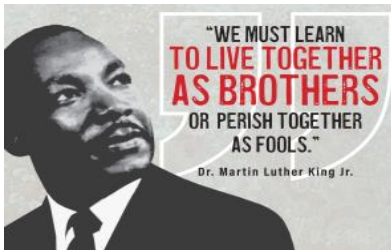
Sermon: The Common Good
