Daily Practice

There are several ways to get started on your Daily Practice. Find a devotional that works for you. For those who like to have a hard copy to read, you can pick up a quarterly devotional book entitled “These Days”. These booklets are available in regular and large print additions. We also have Lenten Devotionals available for children and adults. Lent starts on Ash Wednesday, March 2, 2022. You can find these resources at the Vision Resource Table in the lobby of the sanctuary.

You could also seek out a year-long devotional book that might suit you. Sarah Young is an excellent author and has several daily devotional books for sale. Anne Graham Lotz also has several excellent devotional books. My favorite author is Max Lucado, and he also has numerous

devotional books available. Visit your favorite bookstore or try Amazon to find something that works for you.

If you find a different resource that is helpful to you, be sure to write it up in a brief note or email and share it with Jeff or Jamey so we can share it with the congregation.

If you click on the date of the upcoming Sunday, the Activity Sheets will follow along with Pastor Jeff's scripture. This is another way to connect with your children, in a fun and educational way about God!
