The lessons are taught by certified teachers and at costs below the market rate. The goal is to make lessons accessible for all students and scholarships are available.

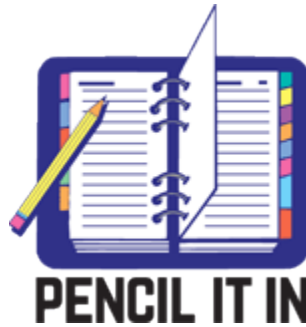
