Chickie Miller – Undergoing chemo treatment for cancer - friend of John and Karen Shaver

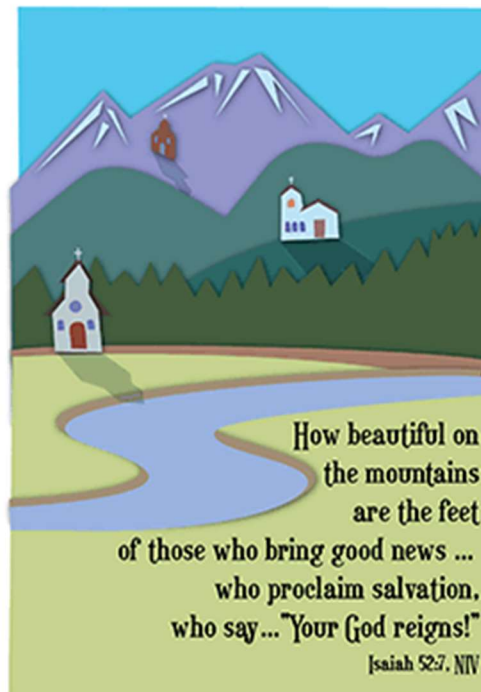
