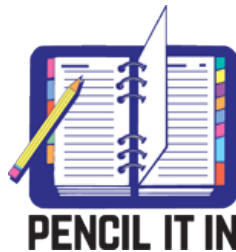
Dinners for Eight

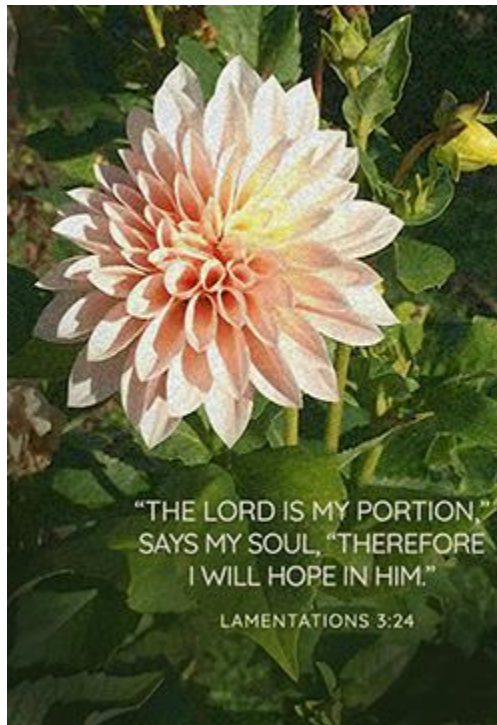
