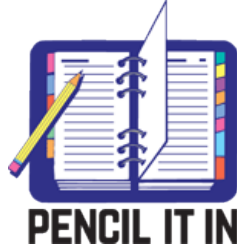

**ARE YOU TRYING TO FIND A PLACE** - to serve in the church where you can make a difference and enjoy what you're doing at the same time? Do you enjoy music and have basic rhythm and counting skills? Do you have an hour a week to devote to practice? Consider joining the Beginner's Handbell Choir. The Music Ministry will be offering a handbell clinic on the following days for anyone who might like to give Handbell ringing a risk free try! The dates are Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup> from 1:00-4:00 pm, Sunday, August 21<sup>st</sup> and Sunday, August 28<sup>th</sup> from 3:00-6:00 pm. The Clinic will be divided into three 1 Hour sessions to focus on different skill levels and to give the ringer an opportunity to learn handbells in a low-pressure environment. The three sessions are:

- Hour One – Handbells 101 – Beginners Technique for those with little to no exposure to handbell ringing.
- Hour Two – Basic Technique for ringers who are ready to progress beyond a beginning knowledge of Handbell Ringing. This will include items such as Dampening, how to turn the clapper to produce the level of sound needed, Musical Terminology, Music Scales, Precision, Handbell Symbols, and accompanying techniques.
- Advanced Bell Ringing – So you're feeling pretty good about your knowledge and are ready to go a little bit further in your journey? Great! This class will offer you the opportunity to learn advanced Handbell skills such as 4 in hand, flexibility in moving to other octaves when needed, Uncommon Time Signatures, Handbell Changing Technique, Dynamic Sensitivity and Fast Ringing.
