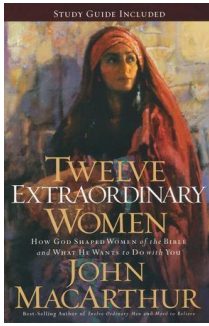
GEORGE THROWER MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT – There will be a meeting immediately after church on Sunday, August 21st in the parlor.
