

Church Center App: Get access! Realm will be going away by the end of February!


On your computer (laptop or desktop):



Church Center Giving

All electronic giving is now through Church Center Giving.

- Login to Church Center either through your phone, tablet, laptop, or desktop computer
- Select "Give"
- Your laptop or desktop will have this screen



- You can select:
 - Your donation amount
 - o Particular fund from the drop down menu
 - on your phone you will need to put in a dollar amount to see the funds drop down menu
 - Fund options:
 - General
 - Flowers
 - Memorials
 - Good Samaritan Fund
 - Building Fund
 - 10 Cents a Meal
 - [Passthrough options will appear as need]
 - You can NOT split one donation between multiple pull down options. Each item must be paid separate, ie: 10 Cents a Meal separate from General Fund [there is no longer a memo line]
 - You can set separate recurring donations for different funds.
 - I.e.: General for regular giving and 10 Cents a Meal to recur on the last Sunday of each month.
 - One time or recurring donation
 - You can choose the day
 - Weekly
 - Every-other week/twice monthly
 - Monthly
 - You can select to add your bank account and use the ACH method of automatically withdrawing from your checking account.
 - You can select to use a debit or credit card.
