## Odds and Ends

Dear Church Family,

I want to take this opportunity to thank you so much for your continued prayers and support. Thank you for supporting and taking good care of my wife Grace Kuto while I am away. This means a lot to me and my kids. We really appreciate it.

I arrived here in Kenya safely and hit the ground running and got so busy hence the delay in getting in touch. Also the internet service in the village is very sporadic and not reliable for communications, you have to time it well.

The work with the community water project is finally going well after a few hiccups that Grace might have shared with you by now, but God has been faithful to us. A solar pump was finally installed and water has started flowing in the three big tanks. We are now in a one month monitoring stage for the efficiency of the solar pump and so far

things are going very well. The villagers have started using the water and they are very thankful for your assistance.

When all is successfully completed and upon my return to Charlotte, I will give a full report of the project and its impact to this community. I am working with our water engineer on the ground to make sure that all the systems of the water project are working well and normal before I fly back to the US. On behalf of this community at large, I send our prayers and enormous gratitudes to you all as our church family.

Go ahead and start making the cookies and freeze them. If you don't have enough room in your home freezer, there is freezer space at the church. These cookies are so important to those that are incarcerated. Please pray over your cookies as a source of His love to shine on the prisoners and the staff. Pray that each cookie brings the inmate, officer or warden who eats one closer to God.

THE GUIDELINES THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED ARE FROM THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

<u>DO NOT DEVIATE</u>, OR THE COOKIES WILL NOT BE DELIVERED.

#### Cookie Guidelines

The types of cookies that are acceptable are:

Chocolate chip, sugar, ginger, molasses, oatmeal and peanut butter.

Cookies should be between TWO (2) and TWO AND ONE HALF (2.5) INCHES ACROSS and not more than half (0.5) inch thick.

DO NOT USE ICING, POWDERED SUGAR OR ANY OTHER TYPE OF COATING ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE COOKIE. DO NOT ADD ANY KIND OF FRUIT OR NUTS TO THE COOKIES.

IMPORTANT: Bag thoroughly cooled cookies in a clear QUART sized zip lock bag only. A dozen cookies to a bag. We cannot re-bag or hand-out in any other packaging.
