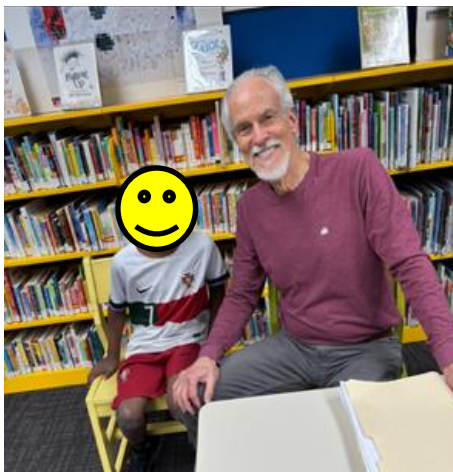

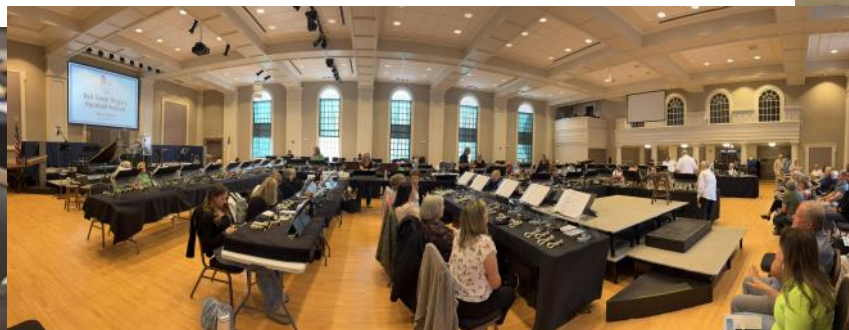

Hannah graduated from Sunshine School and went to Pheiffer University in the fall. She was so homesick for her family, she left after one semester and moved to Charlotte to live with her sister and attend business school. She wore a beautiful dress her sister Eloise made her.

She worked for Radiator Specialty for over 50 years and retired as payroll manager.

We celebrated her 101st Birthday on Sunday and she was her unique, funny self for family and friends.

She is preceded in death by her husband Butch, her parents, two brothers Foy and Preston Melton, and two sisters Eloise Stilwell and Loretta Lemmond.

She is survived by her sister Margaret Cline Wert and many nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews and great-great nieces and nephews. Hannah loved those children.

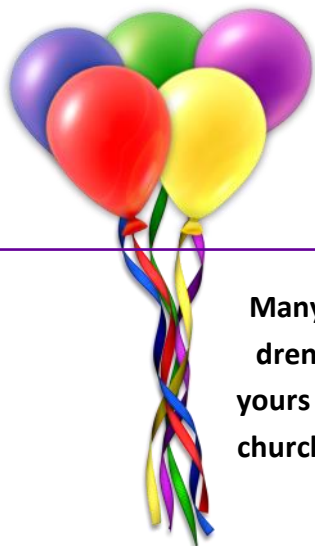

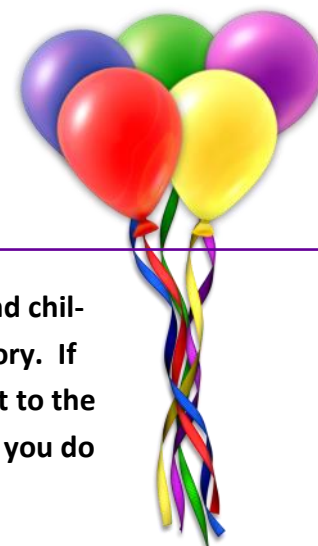
### **Important**
